Who: All varsity and novice athletes will compete.

Parking: In Green Lake or Lower Woodland parking lots. Please do not park on the street. SPD is aggressive about towing cars parked in no-park zones.

Schedule: Order of races will be released the week of the regatta.

Novice Boys and Girls: Rowers to be at the course at 6:00 AM sharp to rig and prepare for racing.

Varsity Boys and Girls: Rowers to be at course at 7:30 AM sharp to rig and prepare for racing.

Dismissal Time: Athletes to be dismissed when their equipment is loaded on the trailer.

Food: The ERA Parent Booster Club will be hosting the mobile kitchen at this event. Please sign up for a shift to help feed the athletes.

Preparedness: Athletes should be sure to bring sunscreen and layers of clothing in the event of inclement weather.

Weather Policy: If conditions prohibit safe rowing, events will be shortened, an alternate course will be used or the event will be cancelled. This decision is made by the referees, with support of the coaches and organizing committee.

Viewing: From the south west shore of the lake, near the small craft center.

Chairs: Athletes should bring their own folding chairs, or blankets to sit upon during the regatta.

Food Tent: The Parent Booster Club will provide hot meals for athletes throughout the day. We need many volunteers to ensure our athletes are well fed and ready to race. Please sign up for a shift online before the event. This is a great way to get involved and help out!

Green Lake FAQ:

"Open" Novice category includes adult beginning rowers. Typically, our second novice boats race in this category.

Varsity, JV and 3V crews will face off in a round-robin of 1,000 meter pieces in a dual-race format. Each crew will race the other in 8's, providing more chances for racing in a shorter time frame.
